

SWRHA AFFILIATE STANDINGS CONDITIONS

1. The classes offered as qualifying classes are: Open, Intermediate Open, Limited Open, Rookie Professional, Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro, Limited Non Pro, Prime Time Non Pro, Novice Horse Open Level 1, Novice Horse Open Level 2, Novice Horse Non Pro Level 1, Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2, Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18, and Rookie Level 1
2. Per NRHA Riders may qualify in only one region and for only one affiliate. All riders must have an affiliate designated with the NRHA office no later than August 1. Click [Here](#) for the designation form.
3. For points to count toward Affiliate standings a rider must be current at the time of showing. Points will not count retroactively.
4. Points are to be calculated on a one horse/one rider format for all classes.
5. Points will be awarded based on the number of horses actually competing in the class, excluding horses entered but scratched. Zeros, no scores and non-SWRHA members will not be awarded points.
i.e. if fifteen horses compete, 1st place will be awarded 15 points, 2nd – 14 points, etc.
6. The top 15 SWRHA horse and rider combinations plus ties who have won at least half a point will qualify for Affiliate finals.

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR COMPETITION

1. The top 10 horse and rider combinations plus ties from the Rookie Level 1 Affiliate Regional Championship are eligible to compete for the Silver Spurs Equine Rookie of the Year title and trophy at the NRHA Futurity and Championship.

SWRHA YEAR END STANDINGS

1. The classes offered are Open, Intermediate Open, Limited Open, Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro, Limited Non Pro, Novice Horse Open Level 2, Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2, Rookie Level 1, Youth 14-18, Youth 13 & Under, Green Reiner Level 1 and Green Reiner Level 2.
2. For points to count toward Year End standings a rider must be a current member in good standing at the time of showing. Points will not count retroactively.
3. To be eligible for Year End Awards rider/horse combinations must have attended 51% of the available shows. (This is where I was thinking of putting the info on retroactively counting shows for the persons 51%)
4. Open classes are calculated on a one rider/multiple horse format.
5. Non Pro classes are calculated on a one rider/one horse format.
6. Points are awarded based on the number of current SWRHA members in the class.
i.e. 10 people compete in the class but only 6 are current SWRHA members. The highest ranking member will receive 6 points, 2nd highest 5 points, etc.
